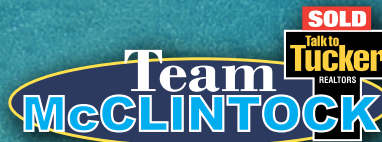

I never met my grandfather, my father's father. He died in 1936 at the young age of fifty-nine (I know some of you find it hard to believe that I wasn't born before 1936.) As I have written before, He was a second-generation general practitioner in Boonville. I really don't know much about him. Still, I do know that he was a graduate of the Indiana University School of Medicine, a Mason and a Noble of the Hadi Shrine, a Methodist and a Republican, a member of the Indiana State Medical Association, and that he practiced his entire career in Boonville with his father. He was active in civic affairs in Boonville and Warrick County and a respected man in his community. In the summer, he liked to play golf in the morning before office hours. He would begin at daylight and play eighteen holes before office hours at 8 AM.

He did not like to drive and did not like to travel. He and his father made house calls all over Warrick, Spencer, and Vanderburgh counties, not only treating the sick but delivering babies and doing surgery (He would perform the surgery while his father administered the open-drop ether.)

My grandmother did tell me one story, a vignette really, which I would like to share with you now.

You may or may not know that Indiana was a hotbed of Ku Klux Klan activity in the 1920s and '30s. The Klan of that day practiced equal hatred for Catholics, Jews, foreigners, African-Americans, and other people of color. Boonville, which in truth had very few Catholics, Jews, or people of color, for some reason had a very large and active Klavern. They made it a practice, as did Klansmen in other cities, to march down Main Street both in daylight and by torchlight, in their full white hooded and white-robed regalia, looking like the penitents in Spain during Holy Week. They were intimidating those who were not just like them or those who were just like them but did not approve of their beliefs or actions.

My grandfather was one of those people.

He could not abide a bully or a coward, or anyone who made it a practice of mistreating other people. What's more, he knew practically every man in Boonville. As a physician, he knew their posture, stature, and walk. He knew if they had one arm shorter than the other, if they were fat or thin, or if they had a club foot or a curvature of the spine. He would stand on the front porch of his house on Main Street as the march went by and yell out at the individual Klansmen, "Bill Miller, who do you think you're hiding from in that idiotic mask? Everyone in town knows that pigeon-toed walk of yours. Heck, Lester, that robe you're wearing doesn't make you any taller. We all know who you are. Jimmy Kelley, that pot-belly of yours still makes you look pregnant even under that sheet." The Klansmen would shake their fists at him and make aggressive gestures, and my grandmother, mortified and frightened, would tell him to hush and to come inside, but he would say to her in an even louder voice, "Ada, what do I have to fear from cowards who don't even have the courage to show their faces?"

Indeed, according to my grandmother, no retribution was ever taken against him. He was, after all, the town doctor and a highly respected man.

He was a man; I like to think, who, long before Reverend Martin Luther King ever said the words, judging people by the content of their character and not the color of their skin.

Or maybe he simply believed in the Golden Rule.

Even in these modern times, it would seem to me that if we all did unto others as we would have others do unto us, most of our social problems would disappear.

Note: All of the names I have used for the Klansmen are made up.
