Why support the Pre to 3 Program?

Pre to 3 is a free, voluntary home-visiting program that supports families during pregnancy and until the baby is 3 years old. Pre to 3 is open to all families with enrollment during pregnancy or before the infant is 90 days old. Each family is supported by a team that includes a Community Health Worker (CHW), Registered Nurse (RN)/Lactation Counselor, and Client Advocate. This team works together to support the family by visiting the family each week, teaching families important skills that support the healthy growth and development of their baby, and connecting the family to community resources.

The infant mortality rate for Vanderburgh County in 2018 was 8.1/1,000 live births. This means approximately 16 infants in Vanderburgh County died before their first birthday. The Pre to 3 program was fully implemented in 2019 to combat the growing infant mortality rate and improve maternal/child health outcomes. The infant mortality rate in Vanderburgh County in 2022 was 5.3/1,000 live births.
